

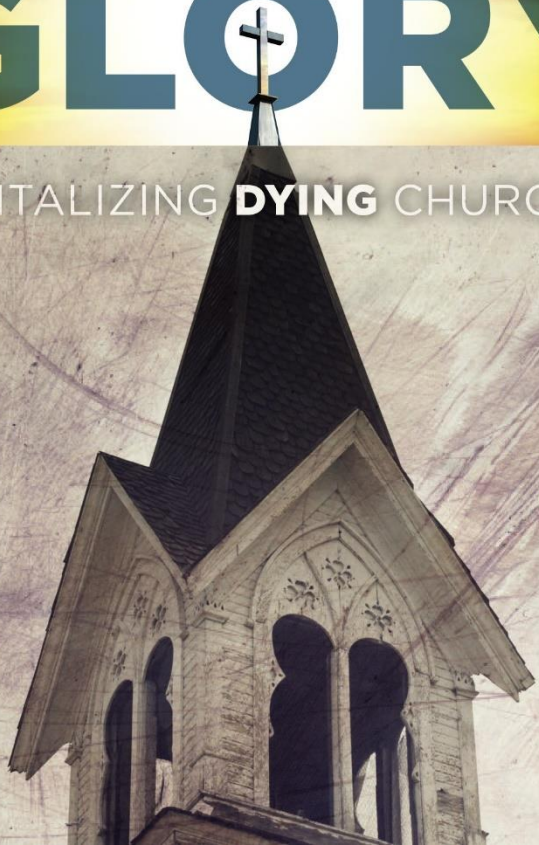

(Beaverton High School, Community Partnership Community, Creekside/Beaverton Lodge, Apartment Ministry, Park Ministry, Family Promise Day Center)
- **Simplify our strategy (Church Health Assessment)**
(in process)

- Focus on reaching young families, couples, singles
(Cor Deo Christian Academy, Church Planting team)
